

1 2. I am an attorney for the Petitioner, Andrew Earl Furer, in the above-entitled
2 action.

4 3. On the morning of July 12, 2004, I had a telephone conversation with Bonnie G.
5 Mahan, Esq., in which she conveyed an alleged concern held by Mrs. Furer that there was not
6 adequate disclosure regarding the parties' assets. At no time during the telephone conversation
7 did Mrs. Mahan or I reach any agreement or understanding regarding this issue as it related to the
8 fully executed Joint Petition For Summary Divorce or the fully executed Marital Settlement
9 Agreement.


10 4. Thereafter, I received a facsimile from Ms. Mahan's office, stating that, based
11 on our previous conversation, "the joint petition is on hold".

12 5. I immediately drafted and sent a letter to Ms. Mahan's office, explaining that
13 Mr. Furer did not agree with the alleged understanding or agreement.

14 6. Thereafter, Ms. Mahan called me, and explained that she was not in her office
15 that morning, had not reviewed the facsimile before it was sent to my office, and understood
16 that we had not reached the alleged understanding or agreement.

17 7. Based on the executed Joint Petition For Divorce, the executed Marital
18 Settlement Agreement, and the agreement reached between the parties, as set forth in Ms.
19 Mahan's letter dated July 8, 2004, I submitted the Joint Petition For Summary Divorce on July
20 12, 2004.
