ORDER FOR RECUSAL AND RANDOM REASSIGNMENT

The court has received Applicant's Objection to Court Master's Recommendations and Order submitted to the Court on September 16, 2008.

According to the Applicant's Motion for Order to Show Cause, dated March 25, 2008, the Adverse Party allegedly made threats that she intended to kill Judge Weller in addition to the Applicant and the Applicant's attorney. Normally, such a threat would not require a judge to recuse himself or herself. However, the particular facts of this case including more than 20-days of hearing in a contested divorce case make recusal appropriate.


