Dear Sandra,

I was surprised around 4:30 pm today when your secretary, Sandy, told me that you had delayed Mr. Furer's signing the marital settlement agreement to July 12, 2004. I thought the purpose of Sandy's coming to the house on Friday, July 2nd was to expedite the signing for filing. Until Sandy was in the house, I did not know that my husband and his lawyer filed a complaint of Divorce also last Friday. After it was faxed to me from your office, I asked Sandy to call you. You told me that you had called the court that it will be withdrawn, and file the marital settlement agreement I was signing and Mr. Furer was supposed to have signed today after their complaint of Divorce was withdrawn (today).

On Monday, July 5th, Sandy called me around 10:00 AM to tell me that Mr. Furer & his lawyer were coming to your office to sign what I signed last Friday, July 2nd. I was surprised by the urgency since it was a holiday and the complaint of Divorce that was filed was not yet withdrawn and dismissed, being a holiday. You told me that it will be withdrawn July 6, today, and I assumed Mr. Furer will be signing the marital settlement agreement, also this day.

I do not know what is happening. Is there something happening I am not aware of? Why are you delaying the signing until next week?

The closing of my house in Las Vegas is on July 29th. I have to be there on the 29th for some important papers for the escrow company. Also my husband can sue me if I am not out of here on time.

These are very delicate items that must be packed very carefully, the reason I do not want several packers all at once in the house. I also have to monitor the packing of every item for the declared value - for the insurance. The furniture and other large items will be packed the following week and ^{will be} hauled away, hopefully on the 24th so I'll have time to have the house cleaned on the 26th.

As you can see my schedule is so hectic add to the fact that I AM THE ONLY ONE DOING THIS - WITH NO HELP AT ALL ~~from~~ ^{OR} the supervision side of these all. I am afraid this move is going to be a mess. I am hoping nothing will get lost.

Dear Mrs. Furer:

I am in receipt of your numerous faxes and telephone messages. Frankly, it is I who am confused by the direction that you wish me to take. Your messages and faxes ask repeatedly what the urgency of this matter is and then repeatedly state that you need more time.

My staff worked on the federal holiday to facilitate obtaining Mr. Furer's signature on the Marital Settlement Agreement, which you signed on Friday, July 2, 2004, yet pursuant to your direction as received on Monday, July 5, 2004, this agreement was not provided to Mr. Furer, because you wanted the Complaint dismissed and a new action initiated to allow for a Joint Petition for Divorce. As your request came on the federal holiday, I was unable to secure Mr. Furer's consent through counsel for said dismissal and new filing until late afternoon on Tuesday, July 6, 2004. Given the need for you to execute the Joint Petition for Divorce prior to the filing of such petition and in recognition of the stressors that you are under in trying to prepare for your move to Las Vegas, I requested that Woodburn and Wedge, as the law firm currently handling your estate planning, prepare all necessary documents to facilitate the transfer of assets as anticipated by the Post-Nuptial Agreement and confirmed or modified by the Marital Settlement Agreement so that all documents requiring your signature could be executed at one time rather than in the piece-meal manner which could result from executing documents as they are prepared and ready for signature.

By way of your faxes, you state that you want all documents completed by tomorrow, July 8, 2004, unfortunately my schedule will not accommodate such a deadline, even if Woodburn and Wedge could complete all the necessary documents for the transfer of assets by tomorrow. However, if you wish to execute the Joint Petition for Divorce and then execute all other documents thereafter, this could be arranged.

① I had faxed you 3 pages of hand written letter -
② I left one (1) message with your secretary to call my cell in case you want to talk to me -

when you insisted that your secretary come to the house for me to sign the papers, I agree because it will be filed July 6, after they withdraw & dismiss the complaint for divorce. Your secretary told me that MR. Furer was going to sign the MSA July 6, NOT 5, SINCE IT WAS A HOLIDAY

I was not in guess now & was questioning why they were going to sign the papers on a holiday when the complaint can't be dismissed, go I SAID - NO!

I was awakened by your secretary's call on Monday July 5, that Mr Furer & his atty. were coming to your office that morning - Holiday to sign - BEFORE THE COMPLAINT FOR DIVORCE WAS DISMISSED!

Mr. Furer is unwilling to dismiss his divorce action until such time as a Joint Petition for Divorce has been executed. You have stated that you are unwilling to provide him with the original executed Marital Settlement Agreement until such time as Mr. Furer has dismissed his Complaint for Divorce. Thus in an effort to obtain the dismissal of the current contested action and the re-filing of a joint action, you must sign the Joint Petition, thereafter Mr. Furer will dismiss the contested action and thereafter I may provide Mr. Furer with the Marital Settlement Agreement for his signature.

As an aside, I disagree with the statement contained in one of your faxes, that you did not know that Mr. Furer had filed a Complaint for Divorce and Ex-Parte Motion prior to meeting with Ms. Best on Friday, July 2, 2004. Throughout our telephone conversations during the late morning of July 2, 2004 I informed you that Mr. Furer had filed such action. Further, I informed you that I had contacted the Court to let them know that I wished to oppose the Ex-Parte Motion. Additionally, I had informed you that the Complaint and Ex-Parte Motion were prepared and ready for filing in conversations we had on Thursday, July 1, 2004.
